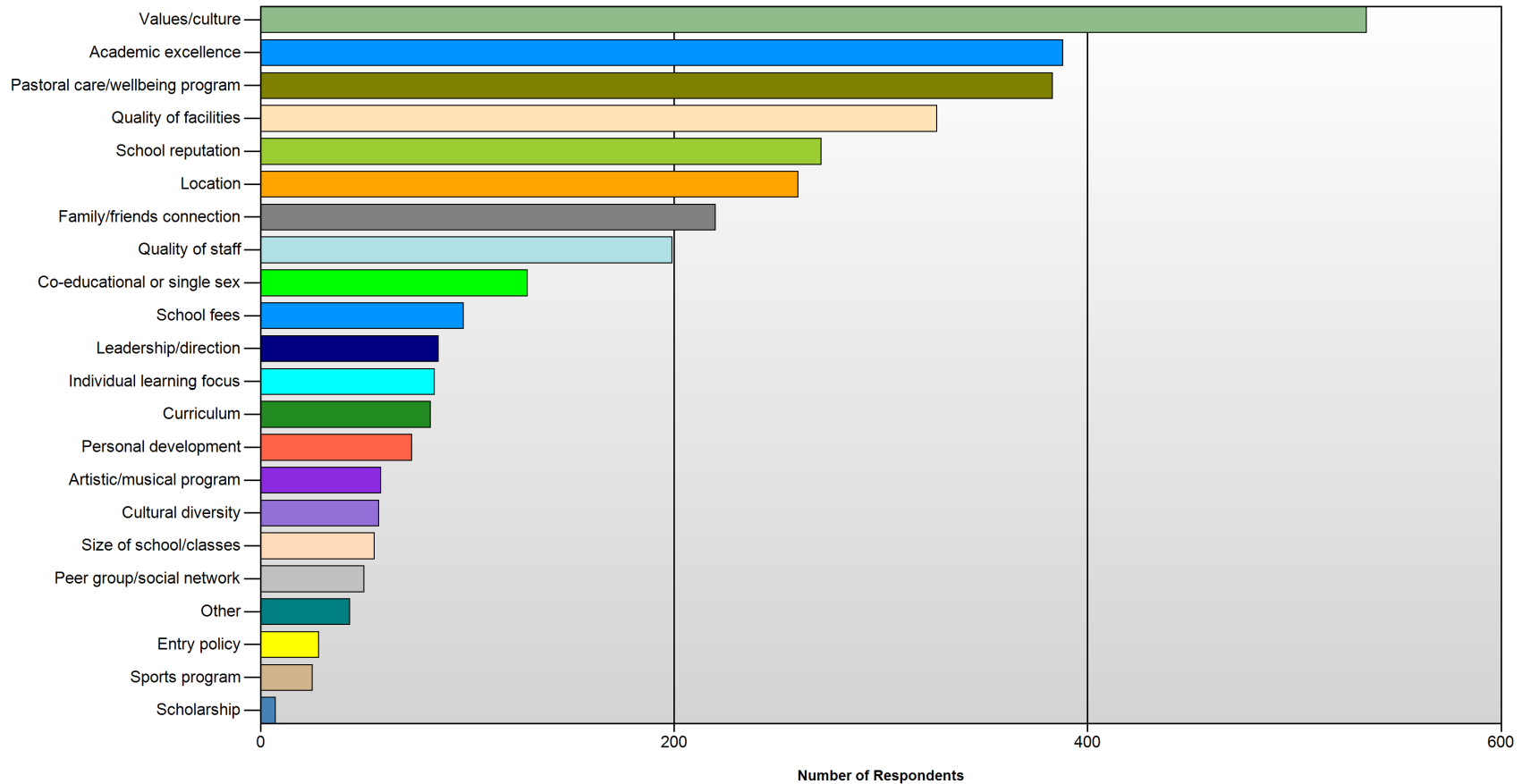

Why do parents choose a private school?

Survey research shows that the main driver of school choice is the desire of parents to match the school with the individual needs of the child and the values of the family. Other reasons parents choose an Independent school for their children include religious affiliation, academic outcomes, particularly at Year 12, quality teaching, a supportive caring environment, the physical environment and facilities, the content of the curriculum, quality leadership and extra-curricular opportunities. Information derived from the last parent survey conducted in August 2014. Citipointe conducts surveys from time to time so parents have an opportunity to provide feedback on their perception of a Citipointe education.

Choosing a private school is an *investment* parents make in the children's education:

If our College is the kind of school you are looking for, Citipointe offers scholarships and bursaries that may help you achieve your goal.

- ❖ A Sibling Bursary is a discounted fee, a family friendly policy, that applies to second or subsequent children in the family.
- ❖ A Scholarship for academic excellence is a discounted fee (up to 50%) based on the results of *Edutest* scholarship testing. (*Edutest* is the company that provides academic testing services to Citipointe.)
- ❖ An Equity Scholarship is a discounted fee available where there is a demonstrated need, there are vacancies, and an enrolment application has been made.



Only private schools have a contractual relationship with their parents.

The benefits of an all-inclusive tuition fee

At Citipointe, there are no extra fees for day excursions, weekly sport, district and ICS sport, year level camps, secondary specialist subject camps, examination fees charged by government, academic competition fees, end of year activities on campus, Secondary textbooks and iPad apps for curriculum use. The all-inclusive fee helps families budget and plan ahead.

If you wish to provide your child with extra-curricular activities where costs are involved, a fee for service will apply e.g. certain extra-curricular sports and activities, tutoring through Citipointe Christian College Academy (not to be confused with the College's Academy of Arts), international travel under the International Student Outreach Program, or musical instrument hiring.
